**What:** A dynamically constructed, responsive web calendar.

Some formatting is accomplished with the help of [Bootstrap](#), (though no familiarity with Bootstrap is needed in order to use this calendar.)

**How:** The LiveCode scripting language is used to create an html calendar and populate it with events. The LiveCode server engine needs to be installed on your web server in order for this to work. Like perl and php, some ISPs have LiveCode preinstalled (<https://hostm.com> and <https://livecode.com/hosting>) but many do not.

The calendar\_demo.lc page expects that the "images" folder, "css" folder and "calendar\_events\_data" folder are all in the same directory as itself... though of course you can reconfigure this by editing the calendar\_demo.lc file. The "calendar\_events\_data" folder is where the text file(s), which contain your custom calendar events, are stored. Use a Calendar Events standalone app to create and publish these event files.
